

二年级英语上第六周阅读主题：星期

文章梗概：

本节课的阅读题目是《The Very Hungry Caterpillar》。这是一本绘本故事书，它是国际儿童文学大师、绘本专家 Eric Carle 的经典之作。故事内容其实很简单，就是讲述了一条毛毛虫吃了很多食物，然后变成蛹，最后变成蝴蝶的过程。这是一个普通的自然现象，但在卡爷爷的笔下竟然如此的生动，有趣。难怪这本书会荣获无数大奖，至今依然被奉为经典流传至今。

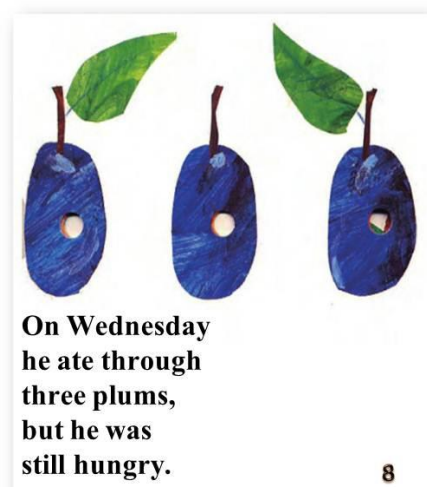
文章讲述了一条毛毛虫蜕变成蝴蝶的故事。教师通过整体呈现绘本阅读内容，引导学生按照故事的发展顺序将五幅图片排列。在阅读过程中，学生通过观察故事中的图片信息，能很轻松地理解新授词汇的含义。另外，教师通过布置相关的阅读任务，也激发了学生的阅读兴趣。

阅读任务：

1. What did the very hungry caterpillar become at the end? (饥饿的毛毛虫最终变成了什么?)
 - A. A cuttlefish.
 - B. A butterfly.
 - C. A bird.

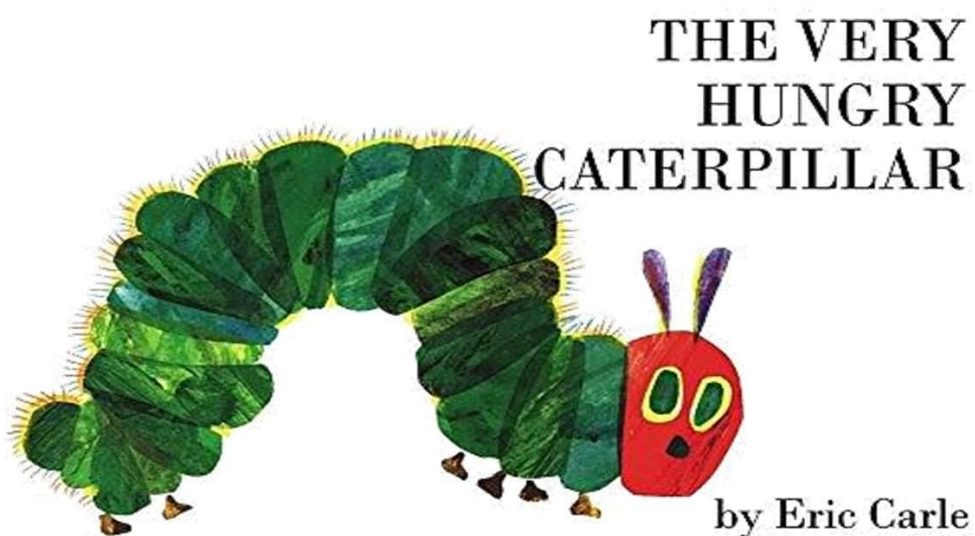

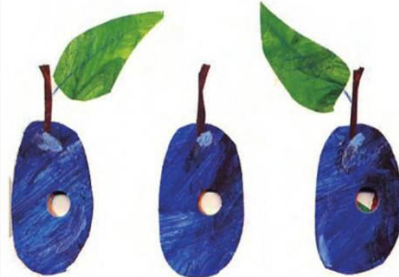

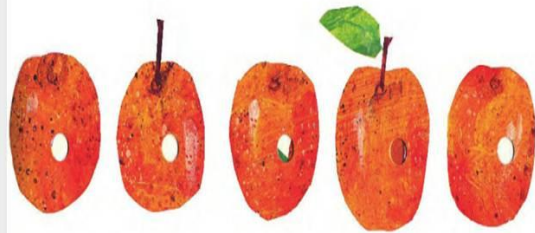
